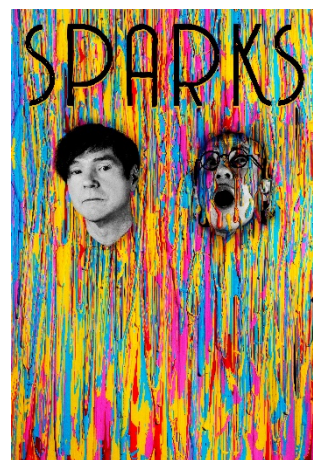

Since storming into the charts, minds and airwaves in 1974 with 'This Town Ain't Big Enough For Both of Us' from their 3rd album 'Kimono My House', the *musically vital* pop pioneers have created a unique legacy both on record and in their live performances.
