

## Sparks Enter UK Top 10 With 24<sup>th</sup> Studio Album

Sparks' 24<sup>th</sup> studio album 'A Steady Drip, Drip, Drip' has today entered the Official UK Charts at Number 7.

Replicating the success of their 2017 album 'Hippopotamus', 'A Steady Drip, Drip, Drip' becomes the band's second UK top 10 album since 1974, when 'Kimono My House' and 'Propaganda' reached number 4 and 9 respectively. 'A Steady Drip, Drip, Drip', which was originally released digitally in May to universal acclaim, also enters the Independent Album Chart at Number 1 following the physical release on July 3<sup>rd</sup>.

On hearing the news Ron and Russell Mael said "When making a record we determine to be adventurous and bold, to take risks and never compromise, and to make the best pop record we can. It means a lot that there is an audience who appreciate that. Thank you."
